# RESPONSIVE READING: 1 CORINTHIANS 13

**LEADER: 1** Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

**CONGREGATION: 2** And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.

**LEADER: 3** And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.

**CONGREGATION: 4** Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

**LEADER: 5** Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

**CONGREGATION: 6** Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

**LEADER: 7** Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

# RESPONSIVE READING: 1 CORINTHIANS 13

**CONGREGATION: 8** Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.

**LEADER: 9** For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.

**CONGREGATION: 10** But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.

**LEADER: 11** When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

**CONGREGATION: 12** For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

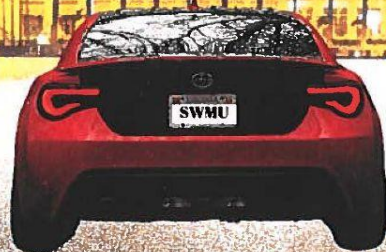
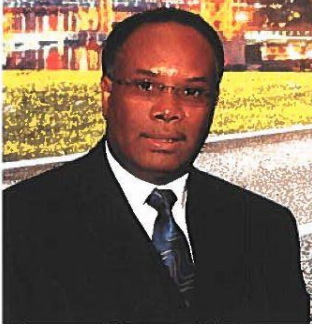

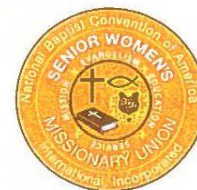
