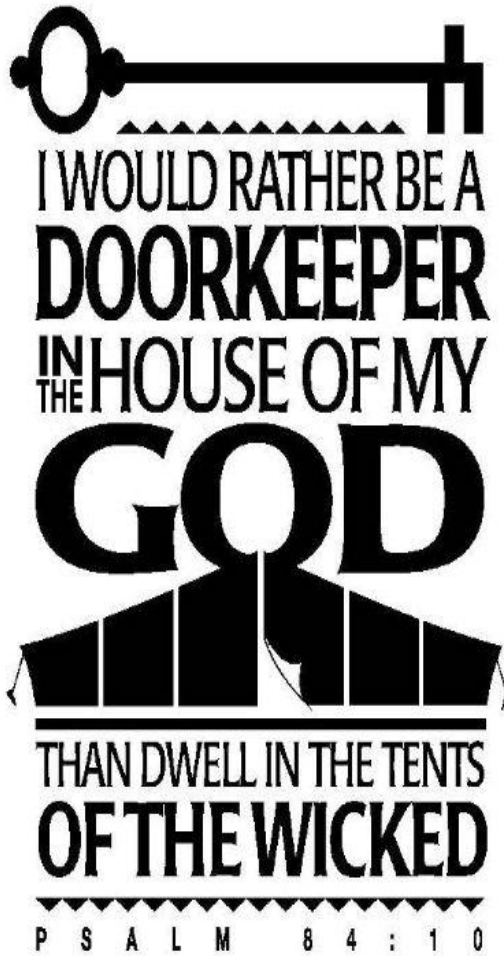

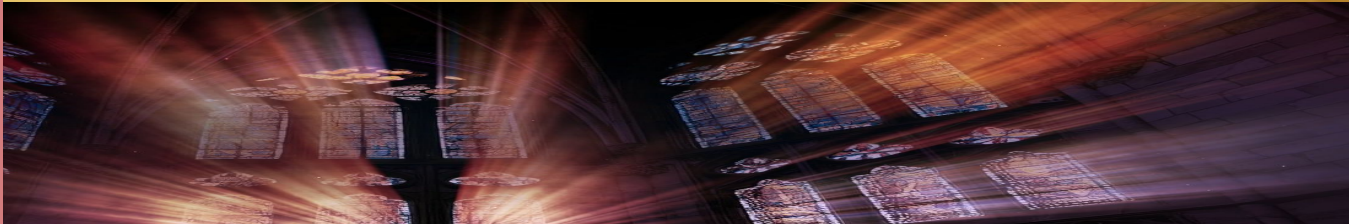

I Forgive and free myself from the weight of resentment.

Knowing this, I pray for the capacity to forgive. If a lack of forgiveness keeps me from the fullness of life, I turn to the Divine within me to discover peace beyond the struggle and love beyond the pain. Forgiveness is the way.
