RESPONSIVE READING: EXODUS 29:1-9 [NIV]

LEADER: ¹This is what you are to do to consecrate them, so they may serve me as priests: Take a young bull and two rams without defect.

CONGREGATION: ²And from the finest wheat flour make round loaves without yeast, thick loaves without yeast and with olive oil mixed in, and thin loaves without yeast and brushed with olive oil.

LEADER: ³Put them in a basket and present them along with the bull and the two rams.

CONGREGATION: ⁴Then bring Aaron and his sons to the entrance to the tent of meeting and wash them with water.

RESPONSIVE READING: EXODUS 29:1-9 [NIV]

LEADER: ⁵Take the garments and dress Aaron with the tunic, the robe of the ephod, the ephod itself and the breastpiece. Fasten the ephod on him by its skillfully woven waistband.

CONGREGATION: ⁶Put the turban on his head and attach the sacred emblem to the turban.

LEADER: ⁷Take the anointing oil and anoint him by pouring it on his head.

CONGREGATION: ⁸Bring his sons and dress them in tunics.

ALL-TOGETHER: ⁹and fasten caps on them. Then tie sashes on Aaron and his sons. The priesthood is theirs by a lasting ordinance.
