2. **Understanding** : Insight into the deeper truths of faith.
3. **Counsel** : The ability to guide others in making choices.
4. **Might** : Strength to overcome challenges and difficulties.
5. **Knowledge** : Understanding of God's will and the mysteries of faith.
6. **Fear of the Lord** : A deep respect and reverence for God.
7. **Faith** : Trust in God and His promises.
8. **Healing** : The ability to restore health to the sick.
9. **Miracles** : The ability to perform extraordinary acts through God's power.
